Holy Week commemorates the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

• SCHEDULE OF OBSERVANCE •

Palm Sunday – March 29

Commemoration of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Blessing of palms.

Holy Monday to Holy Wednesday – March 30 – April 1

Days of prayer, repentance, and reflection.

"Spy Wednesday" recalls Judas' betrayal.

Maundy Thursday – April 2

Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper; Institution of the Eucharist.

Good Friday – April 3

Solemn remembrance of Christ's Passion and Death.

Day of fasting and abstinence.

Holy Saturday – April 4

Day of silence and waiting.

Easter Vigil celebrated at night.

Easter Sunday – April 5

Celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.
